



On May 18, 2016, the Department of Labor published the Final Rule updating the overtime regulations which will extend overtime protections to more than 4 million workers on December 1, 2016. Specifically, the Final Rule increases the set salary standard for exempt employees from \$23,660 annually to \$47,476 annually. The impact of this salary threshold increase is dramatic to business owners. Ms. McKay is an experienced

trial attorney representing national and regional clients in federal and state courts. Her presentation will outline who qualifies as exempt (Executive, Administrative and Professionals) and how the new salary threshold is to be applied. She will also offer tips to prepare for the upcoming change.
